

39th Infantry Regiment Info Sheet and FAQ (10/2020)

Group Standing Orders:

You will require a valid Public Liability Insurance (PLI) in order to attend events with the 39th Inf Reg. you require PLI for the UK, we personally recommend the All Front's Re-enactment Association (AFRA). You must be over the age of 16 to join this group. Please visit their website or Facebook page for more details.

Whilst attending events with the 39th Inf Reg, Shows Expectations (See below) must be adhered to.

Prior to attending a show, please ensure all kit is available and you have brought enough of your own personal kit. The evening before the show, an inspection of kit and uniform shall be carried out.

Although rank is purely for aesthetic reason, please treat each other with respect. Joshua Boyle is the leader of the group and as such any advice given must be taken.

Show Expectations:

We expect a high level of kit, attention to detail and we want to really show off the group and be an ambassador for an under-represented nation.

Because of this we ask that no mobile phone is to be out on the display, and if a call must be taken/received that it is done off of the display. If photos are wanting to be taken this is an acceptable use of the phone.

Personal hygiene and care is expected. Therefore, please ensure you look after your body, especially feet by changing socks regularly when wet. There will be alcohol on site, but please, drink responsibly. We will be conducting events in a semi-immersive state, meaning that the public are not to be interacted with whilst on patrol or sentry. If you're 'off duty' you can interact with the public, answering questions etc. Everyone will be expected to carry out four duties, which are cooking, cleaning, patrolling and sentry. These will be decided each morning. The rest of the time you're not taking part in one of these four duties, the time is your 'off duty' time.

Frequently Ask Questions:

Q: Where do we get our uniforms from?

A: We get our uniforms custom made by an experienced tailor in Romania called Marius. All our uniforms and webbing are made by hand by him, made to order. We do two orders a year, one in around March and one in around November.

Q: How much does an impression cost?

A: Uniforms and webbing cost around £400, with additional costs for boots, helmet and other equipment bringing the cost of an impression to around £600. Costs vary due to materials needed and sizes.

Q: How old do I have to be to join your group?

A: You must be 16 years or older to join our group due to the insurance we use. Unfortunately if you're under 16 you will not be allowed to join our group. We also try to organise a phone call or physical meet so we can see whether you will be compatible with the group.

Q: Where is your group based?

A: We are primarily based in the South-East of England (Kent, London and Sussex) however we do have members who travel down from Yorkshire and Staffordshire for events. You must live in the UK to be a member of our group.

Q: What's the minimum amount of time we have to give up for the group?

A: Our group does around 4/5 public shows a year, which you're expected to attend at least 1 of each year. We also aim to do 2 private events each year, which are optional, but advised.
